


# SNEAK PEEK

“Trendy, charming and full of potential,” that’s how realtors describe houses in the Elizabeth neighborhood. Just 5 minutes from Uptown, this small community is one of the most sought after neighborhoods in Charlotte. A majority of the houses were built in the early 1900s, and each house is totally unique. Most feature front or side porches. Any given evening you will find families sitting on their porches or taking a stroll down the tree lined sidewalks.

Young families love these houses. Although small – most homes are less than 1,300 square feet with only two bedrooms, the original bathroom

and kitchen – they can still be pricey.

Falling in love with a neighborhood can be an expensive proposition especially when your family starts growing. *For Your Home*, the popular national PBS home show, recently undertook the renovation of a small 1,200 square foot arts and crafts bungalow on Fifth Street.

With a growing family, the homeowners needed more space. *For Your Home’s* goal was to add an additional 900 square feet to accommodate two additional bedrooms, a kitchen that didn’t double as a laundry room and two new bathrooms. Bigger challenge, stay within the \$225,000 budget.

The *For Your Home* team, led by host and designer Vicki Payne, consisted of well known space utilization design expert, Jeanine DeVaney and custom homebuilder and renovation specialist, Shannon Miller. The project will take 6 months to complete and an army of trades people and manufacturers.
